
Village Congestion & 20mph zone: Loading is still a problem but Buses turning into Charlton Church Lane or stopping outside Charlton House also cause traffic build up.



Traffic



20mph zone: working well, particularly along Charlton Road and through Village. Junction of Victoria Way there is a confusion of traffic turning in a variety of directions. The 'Continuous" pathway is dangerous as there is no obvious right of way in favour of pedestrians





Service Roads — Fletching Road a lot tidier.

Western end tidier than further east as mainly residential and gated.





The International Store Flats: CS had several discussions with the new owner as to its design and problems the Village was facing prior to development resulting in good design and relationship with the road.

The Co-op is exemplary in its use of the service roads but this has an impact on the visual quality of their loading bay.





Improve gardens:

The western end of Fletching Road. The worst kept gardens relate mainly to empty shops. Identify gardens with shop owners / traders. Programme of tidy-up – by whom?





Fletching Road now links directly to Charlton Church Lane via the newly built Meridian Housing.





Fletching Road seen from junction with Charlton Church Lane, adjacent to 486 & 380 bus stop.





Service Roads — Torrance Road showing old gateway into Charlton Park on left. Some new gates and evidence that owners / traders using their property for parking on the right.










Earle Place: 2018
